

ADMISSION POLICY

Students are admitted to Nursery, KG-1 & KG-2 in the current academic year. Procedure of admissions for the same includes Registration, meeting/verification etc. A child who has completed 3 years to 6 years as on 1st April can apply for admission in the current academic year. There will not be any entrance examination for Nursery & KG-1. However at the time of admission both the parents should be present.

The school authorities reserve all rights of admitting any child to the school. They are not bound to give reasons for admission or rejection of any particular child.

For Admission to higher classes, is based on vacancies available in each class and the admission is given on the basis of student aptitude test, given priority to transfer cases. However, in respect of admission the decision of Principal is final and binding.



Application forms for registration could be obtained from school office/online, between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm. The duly filled forms should be submitted to the school office on the scheduled dates-between 8:00 am and 2:00 pm with following documents.

- a) A self-attested photocopy of the original date of Birth certificate issued by concerned Government authority & a copy of Aadhar card.
- b) A photo of the Child along with the parents (a joint photo).
- c) Two passport size photographs of the child.

MEETING /IDENTIFICATION

The date and time of identification are intimated (See the acknowledgement card) at the time of submitting the duly filled in Registration Form. Change in date and time of meeting/identification will not be entertained.

The meeting is held for the identification of the candidates and parents more for security reasons than any other. During the meeting no academic tests are held, no questions are asked to measure the intelligence and knowledge of the child. Every child has right to go school and we make no discrimination on the basis of caste, creed, sex, economic status or social status. However, we admit only as many as we can. This is a co-educational institution keeping 50% (fifty percent) seats for both boys and girls i.e. equality in seats in each class.

SCHOOL UNIFORM

NURSERY & KINDERGARTEN:

Summer: Navy Blue - Maroon check tunic (Girls), Navy blue shirt, Navy Blue - Maroon check half pants with bib and gallies (Boys), black shoes and maroon with navy blue stripes socks.

Winter: Maroon leggings (Girls), Navy blue - Maroon check full pants (Boys). Maroon 'V' necked sweater with yellow stripes on the neck and Maroon Blazer.

CLASS: I-V

Summer: Arctic blue-White check shirt (Boys & Girls), Ocean blue half pants (Boys) and Pinaforetunic (Girls), Ocean blue with Arctic blue stripes socks and black shoes.

Winter: Ocean blue leggings (Girls) and full pants (Boys), Ocean blue "V necked sweater with arctic blue stripes on the neck and Ocean blue Blazer.

CLASS: VI & ABOVE

Summer: Arctic blue-white check Kurta, Ocean blue Salwar and Jacket (Girls). Arctic Blue - white check shirt, Ocean blue full pants (Boys), stripes socks and black shoes.

Winter: Sweater and Blazer remain same as of junior Classes.

P.T. UNIFORM

White tunic (Girls). White shirt and White half Pants with bib and gallies (Boys), White canvas shoes and White socks, (Classes Nursery to KG-2) White full pants for boys (Classes: I & above). White divided skirt for girls and white leggings (only during winter) (Classes: 1-V), respective house colour T-Shirts, white socks and white canvas shoes White Kurta-Salwar with respective house colour Jackets with white linings for girls (Classes: VI & above)

DETAILS OF THE FEE STRUCTURE

- 1. Every pupil shall pay fees of 12 months.
- 2. Fees will be collected on quarterly basis.
- 3. Fees will be submitted in the bank/school portal.
- 4. No reduction of fee is made on account of mid summer and winter holidays or other vacations ortemporary absence.
- 5. All payments must be made before the date



specified in the fee book. Parents will kindly keep the receipts issued to them and produce them in proof of payment, if needed.

No child will be permitted to begin a new term unless all arrears due on his/her account have been cleared in full before the commencement of the new term. A student not paying fees will have to pay a fine per each passing month in addition to the arrears.

CO-CURRICULAR ACTIVITIES

The school believes in all round education along with academics. It equally emphasize on activities like Speech, Singing, Dancing, Craft, Drawing, Races, Sports, Recitation, Fancy Dress, etc. These activities are conducted throughout the year and winners are awarded.
